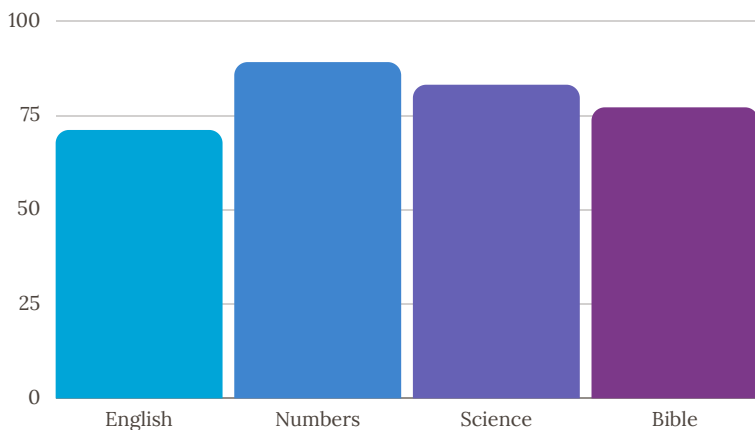


# EDUCATION RESTART
